
Water For Elephants Cleveland

I have been working with Senator Bill Reineke and his office in Columbus for a fun day. Bill represents the 26th District in the Ohio Senate, which includes Union, Crawford, Marion, Morrow, Sandusky, Seneca, and Wyandot Counties. He is currently serving his second term as State Senator and was elected by his colleagues as President Pro tempore for the 136th General Assembly. Senator Reineke previously served three terms in the Ohio House of Representatives. He has worked closely with the Seneca County Chamber of Commerce, Tiffin Seneca Economic Partnership, Tiffin Tomorrow, and Tiffin Rotary Club as a business owner in Tiffin and now represents the district in Columbus.

Our group will have a private tour of both the state Capital and Supreme Court, lunch in the capital café and time for the gift shop. Senator Reineke plans on being with us.

The Statehouse is situated on a 10 acre parcel of land that was donated by John Kerr, Lyne Starling, John Johnston and Alexander McLaughlin, four prominent landholders in the Franklinton area on the west side of the Scioto river. The initial design was arrived at through a design competition. Construction actively began on July 4, 1839 with the ceremonial laying of the cornerstone. The structure would be completed much later, in 1861. Prison labor from the Ohio Penitentiary was used to construct the foundation and ground floors of the building. Objections from skilled tradesman, who felt they were losing out on good-paying jobs, brought about changes in hiring practices for the remainder of the construction.

The Ohio Supreme Court, Ohio's court of last resort, was established in 1803 with the state's constitution. Initially, it consisted of three justices appointed by the state legislature. The court has evolved over time, with changes to the number of justices, election methods, and location. It plays a crucial role in interpreting Ohio law and ensuring checks and balances in the state government.
