

In the heart of Ohio's largest Amish settlement. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this 28 room Oueen Anne style home serves as the society's museum of Victoriana and collection of Holmes County history. Enjoy your visit with us. For a step back in time, walk through our elegant front door and view several interior rooms of Victorian splendor. beautiful museum/mansion was build by L.H. Brightman, a wealthy industrialist from Cleveland. Brightman House, now the Victorian House was built in 1901 and is approximately 7,000 square feet. house has appeared on "Victorian America", an HGTV production. It has also been written up in Victorian Homes magazine.

The Millersburg Glass Museum has found a permanent home on the campus of the Holmes County cultural Center Campus. Inside the interpretive room, guests can familiarize themselves with the history of the local glass plant, it's workers and owner, John Fenton. See magnificent glasswork created from within the bowels of the factory and its kilns. Find out why these sterling masterpieces remain works of art cherished by collectors worldwide.

We will be having a hot lunch served at the Castle Club, a quaint cozy venue. The Club is located right next to the Victorian House and Glass Museums. Elegant dining in the heart of Amish Country. We will have time to visit the lovely shops in Millersburg and a visit to the local ice cream parlor—Miller Creamery.



Join us while we visit our Findlay neighbors on this trip! Our first stop is the Historical Museum—their new building houses cars made in Findlay, Ohio! The museum began with the acquisition of the Hull-Flater House at 422 W. Sandusky St. Findlay, and first opened to the public in 1971. The house was built in 1881 by Jasper Hull, co-founder of the Findlay Artificial Gas and Light Company, and was one of the grandest homes of the day. Today, the home serves as the welcoming "front porch" of an expansive development that has grown to nine facilities. After our docent led tour, you will have a little free time for the gift shop. Then off to Cracker Barrel for lunch.

Last stop is Findlay's Dietsch Brothers Chocolates and Ice Cream. The history of the store began in the last 1920's when Edward Dietsch purchased the C.W. Wickham Candy Co. Unfortunately Edward & his wife both passed away at a young age and the business was forced to close. December 1937 Dietsch Brothers, as you know today opened with the brothers Chris, Don and Roy. Extended family ran the business during WWII until the brothers returned home. Times were tough, sugar was rationed, they worked long hours, family members & their wives helped pack candy during the holidays. The business is still family owned and operated.

Dietch's is very well known in Northwest Ohio for their delicious chocolate and ice cream!! You will be able to purchase Easter Candy from Dietsch's at the time of this trip.
